Get out and Move!

Dr. John Ratey calls physical exercise "Miracle Gro for the brain". Consistent exercise affects the way your brain is able to focus, its ability to deal with stress and anxiety, and its ability to learn.

Some of the best exercise seems to be aerobic and that which takes great balance and has complex movements (such as martial arts and soccer).

Research shows remarkable declines in levels of anxiety, depression and stress and just as remarkable improvements in focus, performance and productivity with regular aerobic exercise.

Exercise RX:

..... a minimum of 25 minutes of aerobic or balancing exercise, 5 days a week. You will know you are exercising hard enough when you just break a sweat (walking is great, but you need to sweat a bit to get the benefits referred to here).
