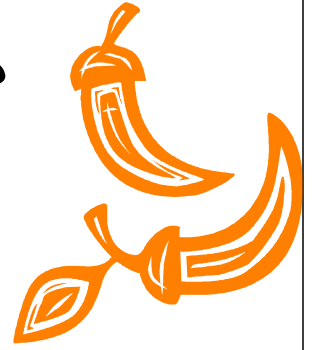

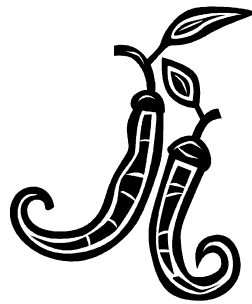

Return the form with your payment **no later than February 1<sup>st</sup>** so that our staff has adequate time to place your ad in the yearbook!
