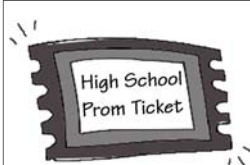

To register for you own account, see Mrs. Thomas in the library or go to <http://www.school.typingpal.com>.

Enter the institution code: **GWSCGWSC**

Enter the student creation access code: **greentpo**

Fill out the registration form and follow the prompts. Once you have a registered account, you can access Typing Pal from any Internet account. Track your progress and advance through the appropriate levels at your own pace. For best results you should practice regularly. Use Typing Pal for 30 minutes a day and within a very short time you will be amazed at your typing skills.
